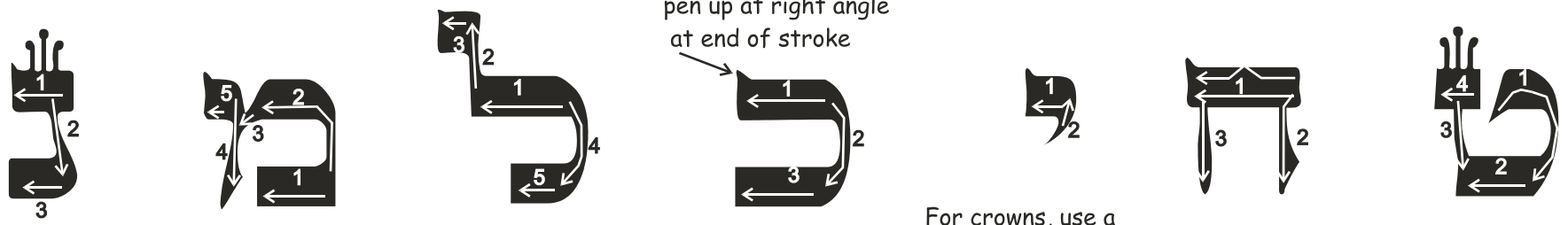
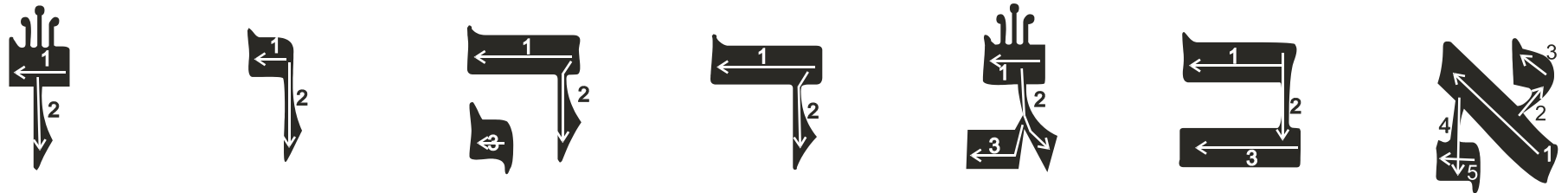


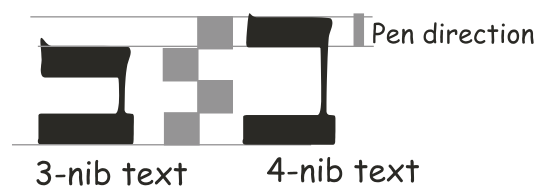
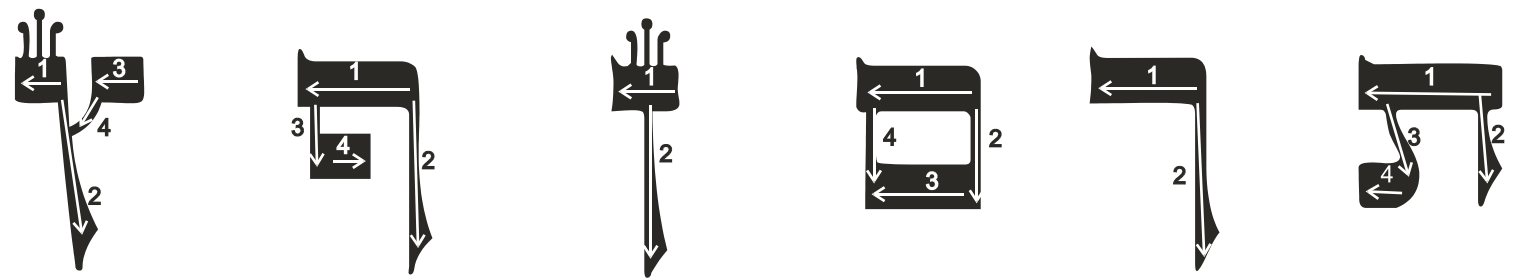
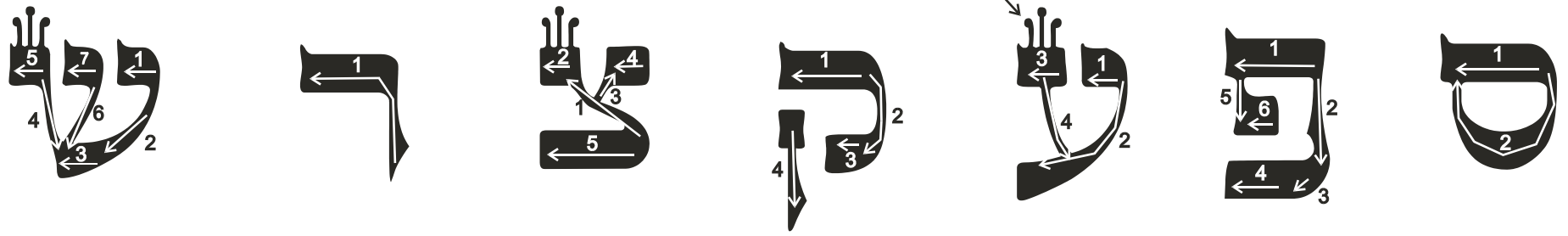
# Shlomo's Hebrew Calligraphy Sheet

How to write Hebrew letters By Steve "Shlomo" Lipton



To get flare move pen up at right angle at end of stroke

For crowns, use a smaller round pen or brush



To make cool Hebrew letters:  
 Use a wide, flat nib fountain pen or brush  
 and keep close to 3-nib character height  
 (nib= with of brush/pen)  
 For some, horizontal lines may be easier in the  
 reverse of the indications here
