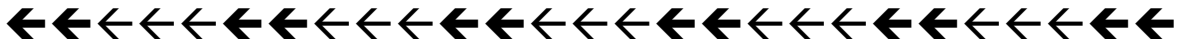

Notes:

- 1) Hebrew reads right to left. ←←Words are read this way←←
- 2) Except for six letters, the dot in the letter called a **dagesh** does not change the sound
- 3) The Vowel sign is usually located under the letter
- 4) The shewa has a "uh" sound at the beginning of a syllable
- 5) Break words into chunks of one vowel each

For example:

אֱלֹ

←←Words are read this way←←
(silent) + ay + L = ayl

רַפָּא

←←Words are read this way←←
1. r+uh =R'
2. Ph+ah+(silent)=Phah
