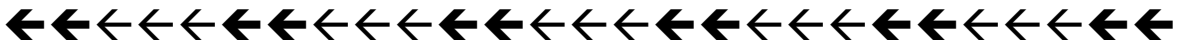

Notes:

- 1) The Tetragrammaton (יהוה) is always pronounced *Adonai*.
- 2) Be careful to watch the dots on top of the shin(ש) and the sin(ש) to tell them apart
- 3) When a Shewa is not the beginning of a syllable, it is silent
- 4) The Holem is a vowel found **above** the the letters, the hiriq **below**.
- 5) If there is no vowel under a yud, it is part of the tzere or hiriq before it
