Notes:

- 1) Be careful not to confuse the Shewa (ְ) and the Meteg (ֻ). The meteg is a solid line which is used to show where the stress of the the syllable falls.
- 2) Some prayerbooks will replace the tetragrammaton (יהוה) with two yud's (יְיִ). Both are pronounced *Adonai*.
